SUMMARY:

This is a unique opportunity for Mexican and foreign volunteers to meet and serve in Chiapas, Mexico. Make new friends as you work alongside other participants and members of the local community. Exchange experiences and discover how much we have in common and how much we have to share.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- Learn ancestral techniques that conserve the Earth without sacrificing yield.
- Participate in the maintenance of agro-ecological projects at the Pej' pem Transformation Center.
- Visit an ecological project in a local indigenous village.
- Relax with visits to the Palenque archaeological site and the area's turquoise waterfalls.

LOCATION: Palenque, Chiapas

COST: Starting at \$700 USD for 7 days/6 nights

TRIP COSTS INCLUDE: Lodging in a shared room, all meals, local transportation, speakers, entrance fees and constant accompaniment by a translator/guide.

NOT INCLUDED: Transportation to Villahermosa (closest airport to Palenque), traveler insurance or personal spending.
